5.1 Cllr Andy Moloney (Ref. ID 2450)

That this council give an update on progress of a previous motion for roundabout or improved road layout at the SuperValu Junction in Cahir.

5.2 Cllr Andy Moloney (Ref. ID 2451)

This leads to vehicles having to risk pulling out onto the busy N24 in an attempt to assess whether the road is clear.

That this Municipal District carry out an assessment of the safety measures in Monard Village with the aim to upgrade the zebra crossing to a pedestrian lights system. At a recent plenary meeting (Feb'22) the Director of Roads stated (in relation to my query re Monard school crossing) that it is not the policy of the council to employ any further school wardens but that the LA could examine the possibility of installing a stop light on demand system.
