6.1 NOM in the name of Councillor S. Hanafin – Id 2671

I am requesting a meeting with Management from Roads Capital Tipperary County Council and the Safety Officer of TII, to discuss safety issues on national and secondary roads in Thurles and all approach roads to Thurles.

Reply to NOM:

If there is consensus among the elected members of Thurles MD to seek a meeting with Roads Capital, Tipperary County Council and the Safety Officer of TII to discuss safety issues on national and secondary roads within Thurles District and all approach roads to Thurles, the District will formally write on behalf of the Members to TII requesting same.

6.2 NOM in the name of Councillor J. Ryan – Id 2672

In light of the recent tragedy in Liberty Square, I am calling on this District Council to request a meeting with the Minister for Transport to see if he can be convinced to include the By Pass project for Thurles in the current National Development Plan.

Reply to NOM:

If there is consensus among the elected members of the Thurles MD to seek a meeting with the Minister for Transport requesting inclusion of a By-Pass around Thurles on the 2040 National Development then the District will formally write, on behalf of the Members, to the Department of Transport requesting same.

6.3 NOM in the name of Councillor J. Ryan – Id 2673

I am calling on this District Council to carry out a safety and traffic survey on Butler, Iona and Innisfallen Avenues in Thurles due to the huge number of traffic that use this road on a daily basis. Residents have requested action to be taken to slow down traffic along this road on health and safety grounds.

Reply to NOM:

As part of the Thurles Local Transport Plan (LTP) detailed surveys were carried out and recommendations were presented to Councillors in the form of two workshops earlier in the year. The LTP recommendations identified traffic calming, footpath enhancements, reduction in speed

limits to 30kph on Butler, Iona and Innisfallen Avenue along with numerous other strategic measures for the wider town.

The Thurles Local Transport Plan has recently been on public display. Therefore we will wait until the completion of the Thurles Local Area Plan and Thurles Local Transport Plan process to assess the implementation of any recommendations.
