Welcome	Ms. Sinéad Carr, Acting Chief Executive congratulated all on their election and extended a special mention to the newly elected members. She was delighted to have them on board to bring fresh voices and different experiences to the council. She stated that she looked forward to working with them. She congratulated the long-standing members and stated that their re-election reflects their hard work and at times hard decision-making and the silent, decent majority had their say in re-electing them and she hoped that this would be remembered by the members when they faced challenging decisions in the coming five years. She stated her commitment to working with them all.
	She acknowledged the difficult challenges faced by the elected members and many are not of their own making and very often the kick back is unwarranted. She acknowledged their resilience and complimented and commended them for that. It was reflective of the calibre of person that the people of this county wish to see as their representatives.
	She committed that she and the executive of the council would support the elected members in delivering for the county and progressing it forward so that citizens and communities can benefit.
	She stated that she hopes that we can deliver on promises made and she extended a welcome to the elected members to come to her at any time to discuss any key programme areas that they wished to see progressed as a result of their engagement with the electorate.



She wished all elected members every success over the next five years and reiterated her full support. She then handed over to the Meetings administrator to progress with the formal elements of the meeting.

Michael Smith proposed that pending the election of the Cathaoirleach that Cllr John Carroll preside over the meeting as the longest-serving member of the Council. Marie Murphy seconded the proposal.

John welcomed all to the meeting, referring to elected members and the executive and all present.

As there were no further nominations <u>CIIr. Declan Burgess</u> was deemed elected Cathaoirleach of Tipperary County Council.

Cllr. Burgess opened the meeting addressing the Deputy Chief Executive Sinead Carr, all Director of Services, Father of the House Cllr John Carroll, Council staff and his fellow public representatives. He stated that he was truly humbled and privileged to today be elected as Chairperson of the Tipperary County Council, in the presence of his family, friends and colleagues.

He said that since being first elected to the County Council in May 2019 he has been determined to bring a fresh energy and sincere commitment to the role. He has enjoyed this tough and exciting recent local election campaign. He was confident that all elected representatives were delighted to be returned to this chamber. He thanked the electorate for being so engaging and acknowledged the members who have not made it over the election line on this occasion. He personally thanked Kevin O'Meara & Tony Black for their contributions.

He welcomed the new County Councillors who are joined for the very first time today. He stated the immense honour it is to represent your area in local government. He advised them to enjoy their time.

Cllr. Burgess stated that he is keen on continuing to play his part along with his colleagues here in this chamber to bring about a positive impact to the communities that they represent. He thanked his proposer and seconder. He stated that Cllr. Hanna Hourigan was the first Councillor he got to know well from their mutual time spent on the Board of the old Tipperary Regional Youth Service. He thanked Cllr. Hanna Hourigan for her endorsement and friendship. He also thanked his Cashel colleague Cllr. Roger Kennedy saying Cllr. Kennedy is a strong voice in this chamber who offers a lot to politics. He thanked the Fine Gael party for putting him forward as their nomination and expressed particular pleasure with the unanimous support of all colleagues in the chamber.

Cllr. Burgess expressed his excitement as being one of the youngest people, at 29, to ever hold the position of Cathaoirleach. He stated his keenness to open the office of Cathaoirleach to the wider community. As a young, elected representative he wishes the council to be reflective of our society stating the importance for this local authority to continue to be ambitious, to meet the challenges head on and drive our great county forward.

Cllr. Burgess expressed a desire to be a fair, balanced, community focused, and effective Chairman. This role symbolises a lot and he said he was humbled and privileged to stand among the members today.



He referred to the fact that his family had no direct involvement in politics and he found himself in the political arena so early and by accident but he felt it wasn't by accident. He referred to the deep care he has for the rich heritage of his community and always enjoyed playing pivotal role in his local area. For him politics was an obvious route where he can do the best for people & county.

As the new Cathaoirleach Cllr. Burgess stated he will try his best to address the issues of the day, to drive on essential services in the towns & villages and to work tirelessly for the next year with all elected members and officials. He stated his intention to support rural communities, to be innovative in how new strategies are developed, and he will aim to enhance green spaces and put all of these on the agenda for the next year.

Over the last five years Cllr. Burgess said he has seen true democracy in action, and is very proud of what the last council has achieved. He has seen what works and what doesn't work. To ensure the next 12 months is a successful one for the county, he said he will ask a lot from the elected representatives.

He said he wants to ensure that the tough questions are asked but also answered and that the best interests of the county are front and centre of our discussions and above all else that all 40 elected members continue to uphold strong values of decency, courage and trust as they go about their individual and collective work. He stated that with support he is confident that the members can reflect in 12 months' time and hold their heads up high.

Cllr. Burgess stated his intention to use his office as a key motivator of economic opportunities in Tipperary and provide an empathetic and creative skill set to ensure ambitions are reached. He told the house that of his keen interest in the tourism potential in the county. As Chair he wants to get down to work and build on successes to date. From food, sport, heritage, art and nature he said there is so much in Tipperary and he will aim that we take it another step and endeavour to ensure that new partnerships are built and our communities are marketed to the best level as the local economies depend on a strong tourism industry.

Cllr. Burgess said that he will work extremely hard to recognise the efforts of volunteers who help shape our localities. He will endorse the campaigns for safer and cleaner communities. As a local authority he said that we must get serious about our environment and must provide a fair framework in how we deal with climate change. He clarified that when he refers to fair he means clear, consistent and realistic. He believes that it is not fair that farmers get timelines presented that will never be achievable but it is also not fair that our streets are allowed to be overrun by weeds. He stated that as a county basics must not be ignored or starved of resources and challenges must be met.



	Cllr. Burgess stated that above all his wish would be that the Tipperary local authority becomes the leading county in providing affordable housing. He said that the squeezed middle must no longer be the forgotten segment when discussing the housing crisis. He referenced schemes like the Ready to Build programme in Boherlahan must be replicated and delivered across the entire county. Tipperary County Council had championed that scheme, and the new council must continue. He said that having a safe and secure home is vital for all and Government's Housing for All programme must be utilised to the best of the council's ability and also, constructively work for more. This item, he said, is priority for him as Cathaoirleach and he trusted there is support in the chamber for a renewed and accelerated programme for affordable homes in Tipperary.  Cllr. Burgess concluded giving thanks and assurance that he will do his best to work hand in hand with the elected members and public officials in the best interest of Tipperary County Council, their set objectives and their county.

The Cathaoirleach noted that the Chairs were not being designated to a particular S.P.C and this would be decided at the July Meeting of the Plenary Council.

The Cathaoirleach advised that in accordance with Schedule 10 paragraph 18 of the local Government Act 2001 where 2 or more persons are to be appointed to a particular body, elected members have the right to form groups to allow for representation on that body.

It is open to any 'group' of Elected Members to obtain an appointment under the grouping system. The number necessary to form a group is calculated by dividing the number of members present at the meeting at the time when the business of making the appointments to the particular body or committee is reached by the number of appointments to be made. The next highest whole number applies when the number so obtained consists of a whole number and a remainder. A person nominated by a group automatically stands appointed on such nomination without a vote.
