6.1 Notice of Motion in the name of Councillor J. Ryan - Id 2869

I am calling on all the relevant bodies to come together to formulate a future plan for the River Suir in Thurles. Currently it is completely overgrown with vegetation, there is no flow or depth and there is always the continuous problem of the green algae forming on the surface. It has become an eyesore and an embarrassment to the town.

Reply to NOM:

If there is a consensus among the elected members, Thurles MD proposes to seek agreement from the relevant bodies to come together to discuss a future plan for the River Suir in Thurles.

LAWPRO will also support the development of a plan.

The factors driving excessive vegetation growth, sedimentation and nuisance algae within the catchment will need to be addressed as part of this plan.

A catchment wide approach to nutrient and river channel management will need to be taken, together with a targeted focus on active management of the river both within and outside the town – to be developed and agreed with the relevant authorities.
